Dear GRO-A Robert and Alice,

I've just come out of the meeting with Channel 4 and thought I'd give you an update... The good news is that they **are** interested in the story and do see it having potential as a stand-alone, big budget one-hour special, maybe in the Dispatches strand.

But they need me to work up the story far more before they'll consider taking it forward (ie. finance). The story they want to go with is a big current-affairs/investigative story that clearly contrasts the UK's lack of response against the response elsewhere... For example, if this were France, our PM and Health Minister would be in the dock facing manslaughter charges etc etc.

This is, I think, the story we all want to get across and would be the most hard-hitting and factual way to present the case. The bad news from my perspective is that I have no available funds to employ researchers (although I am planning to exploit work experience researchers!!) and so am hoping that you may be able help me to speed this up... It would be fantastic if you could help me collate research and hard evidence relating to inquiries elsewhere, and the UK (non-)response. Has there been any level of inquiry here in the UK? Who are the people responsible - at all levels? How have they riggled out of an inquiry? I need evidence/facts/proof and specifically on a UK-wide scale.

You can email or post stuff to me. Feel free to suggest contacts, websites etc etc. Basically, you guys are the best researchers I could ask for and, if you dont mind, any help would be just fantastic!

#### Request for Hepatitis C Inquiry

Mary Scanlon, MSP has asked me if I would update you on the position regarding proposals for an inquiry into infection with hepatitis C as a result of NHS treatment.

You will be aware that Part 5 of the Smoking, Health and Social Care (Scotland) Bill deals with providing a legal basis for the existing system of ex gratia payments. This is quite separate from the Hepatitis C Inquiry issue, and the Health Committee at a later date will be holding a separate evidence session to examine the case for a public inquiry. This session will involve representatives of the Scottish Haemophilia Forum and the Minister for Health and Community Care.

I do not have a date yet for the evidence taking session, but I hope the information I have provided is helpful. If you need to contact me further, I shall be away for the next week, but back home again by 4th April.

The meeting duly took place on Tuesday, and I referred to our correspondence in my short address to the meeting. I have had a second letter from the Minister, Lord Warner, and I am anxious to send it to you as it calls for a response from you. I will also send you a copy of the Report of the All-Party Group which was launched at the meeting. I have asked for extra copies of the Report and as soon as they arrive I will send you these things.

I also now - at last! - have an appointment to see the Top Civil Servant (the Permanent Secretary) in the Department of Health, Sir Nigel Crisp, in about 3 weeks' time. I have asked that he should make available all the files on contaminated blood products and Hepatitis that I would have seen as Secretary of State in 1979 - 1981. (Of course, in those days it was not known as 'Hepatitis C'.)

I will try to keep you informed.
