You will be pleased to hear that we are now in a position to embark upon the project and we have also found a suitable M.L.S.O. to undertake the laboratory investigations for the project. I am, therefore, writing to ask if you would formally accept my proposals for financing of the project. These are as follows:-

If you are in agreement, I would be grateful if a cheque could be made payable to the Haemostasis Research Fund.

You will recall that when Dr. Triger and I visited you in Eastbourne, we asked whether consideration could be given to our purchase of an ultrasonic disintegrator which would greatly facilitate our investigations of neutrophil function. The cost of this equipment is approximately £1,200.

Although we have not as yet formally appointed somebody to the M.L.S.O. post, you will no doubt be pleased to hear that the project is already under way, in that one or two of Dr. Triger's own liver disease patients are currently being investigated. I feel confident that the project will yield useful results, this view being strengthened by the recent paper in the article describing immunological abnormalities in patients with established liver disease (non-haemophiliacs).

I look forward to hearing from you.
