Dear Dr Al-Ismail

Very many thanks for responding so fully and quickly to my request for an update on the HTLV-III status of patients who had received Factorate Batch Y69402.

As I mentioned to you during my visit, one patient who received this batch, some years after previous treatment with non-heat-treated factor VIII, sero-converted, but remains clinically well. For this reason, we have been asked by the DHSS to follow up the progress and history of all other patients who were sero-negative at the time this batch was administered to them.

Of particular interest, therefore, is your patient who was negative in March 1985 but subsequently sero-converted. It would be most valuable to check with you, in strict confidence, the pattern of previous treatment with heat-treated and non-heat-treated factor VIII concentrates. Perhaps this would be best achieved during a visit, if you feel able to disclose this information to me. I would like to contact you again on my return from holiday in the early part of September and arrange to come and see you again.

With regard to the clinical trial on Monoclate to Protocol VIIIC, I have just heard from the USA that they require please a copy of your C.V. and that of Dr Beddall, to accompany the IND documentation that you kindly completed for me a few weeks ago. My apologies for a request for yet more information!

Perhaps we could also discuss this and the current status of the trial during my visit.
