Re: Heat Treated Factorate Batch No. Y69402

I am writing to update you on the HTLVIII status on patients who had received the above batch of Factorate. This is to update the information I passed on to you in my letter of the 7th June, 1985.

- 1. this patient remains HTLVIII negative until his death on the 17th February, 1986 from a cerebral bleed.
- a test done on the 10th June, 1985 confirmed that he is HTLVIII positive. He then developed PGL but this did not progress any further. He remains otherwise generally well.
- 3. this patient was last tested on the 8th May, 1986. He remains HTEVIII negative.
- 4. this patient was last tested on the 16th May, 1986. He remains HTLVIII negative.
- 5. this severe haemophiliac on regular home treatment remains HTLVIII positive. This was first reported on the 2nd. April, 1985.
