ALT TESTING OF DONORS - KOATE HT

I am sorry for not responding sooner. I thought these questions were taken care of during the 16 September phone call with Eli. Also, I just received your 23 September telex today as I have been out of the office.

August of this year marked the date for 100% ALT screened incoming plasma from Cutter owned and contracted plasma centers. However, because of existing inventories of non-screened plasma, there will be a phase-in period before all final product is routinely prepared from 100% ALT screened plasma.

Concerning material from the U.K., Gary Mull has indicated that there is a small lot, 50R070, which is currently at NIBSC. This material was originally prepared for the German market and is 100% ALT screened. There is a second lot, 50R079, which is currently in "work in process" which is not 100% ALT screened. Gary indicated that Linda Frith will advise him whether or not this lot is acceptable. The next lot of Koate HT for the U.K. will be available late November - early December. According to Gary, this lot will mark the beginning of a continuous supply of 100% ALT screened Koate HT for the U.K. This early availability of screened product is possible only due to segregation of plasma and hand selection of the units going into the plasma pool.
