1976	80,000 liters from Nicaragua (9.2% of 873,000 total liters)
1977	114,000 liters from Nicaragua (11.78 of 97# nnn total literal
1978	8,300 liters from Nicaragua (0.7% of 1,223,000 total liters)

No other plasma was imported for our use during these years and we have never procured plasma from Africa for any use including the manufacture of Cutter products.

*Cutter was not producing AHF for export in 1972, consequently this plasma source cannot be implicated in the early transmission of AIDS.
