Dear Ian

I apologise for the delay in writing to you regarding the above.

His usage of factor VIII for his home treatment during the year 1983 was 34,300 units. I think for the severity of his haemophilia, etc. this is a reasonable usage, as some 5,100 units were used for prophylaxis and the rest was involved in active bleeding episodes.

I suppose it would be reasonable to suggest that 3,000 units per month would be approximately right for his management for this year, 1984. I would leave it to your discretion to see whether you thought that would be a reasonable figure, or perhaps we should leave it at 2,000 units and we will supply the discrepancy.

X I totally agree that your comments in your letter of 10 October 1984 that short visits should not in any way be charged against North or South of the border.
