RE: TRIAL QUANTITY OF SPEYWOOD HUMANATE MATERIAL.

I am just writing to say that the patient I tried it on -  
GRO-A, my oldest and most severely affected haemophiliac,  
had unpleasant reactions to it.

The first time he gave himself a dose he had a headache and a  
feeling of flushing around his face. With the second dose some days  
later, he had severe griping abdominal pain immediately after the  
injection which doubled him up for twenty minutes.

I do not feel therefore, that I would want to use this material  
on any other of my patients for fear that they would suffer the same  
unpleasant reactions.
