Jonathon Evans was discharged today from the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre, having been admitted on Wednesday 22 May 1991 with a bleed in his left knee. The pain and swelling has settled with rest in a backplap and treatment with Factor VIII.

We have taken the opportunity to review this patient's general condition. His CD4 lymphocyte count continues to drift slowly downwards and the current value is 0.09 x 10 /L (normal range 0.4-1 x 10 /L. Since the count is now below 0.2 x 10 /L, we have decided to start treatment with co-trianguable two tablets daily as propositive against Phounocystis carnini phousenes. This treatment will be permanent. Unfortunately, our pharmacy will only provide a seven day supply and I would be nost grateful if you could supply the patient with a large quantity. I have therefore requested the patient to contact you about this. I have told the patient that some patients levelop a skin rash with this medication: if this does occur, I have told aim to stop taking the medication and to contact us.

Following Jonathon's recent visit to our combined clinic on John Warin Ward, I have received details of his full blood count which were as follows: haemoglobin 9.7 g/dl, WBC 0.9x10/9L, platelets 52x10/9L. There has been a gradual decrease in the white count over the last few months, which is likely to be due to his co-trimoxazole (septrin) therapy. I have written to Jonathon asking him to stop taking co-trimoxazole until we see him in our next combined clinic.
