The above named boy was transfused with a batch of Hemofil, No: 0591 V 081A1 while at School at Lord Mayor Treloar College.

It has been found that this batch was infected with, what was almost certainly, 'B' hepatitis virus and several of the other boys who received the same batch have become jaundiced, though none of them severely.

Although we are now well past what appeared to be the incubation period of the virus, we felt it necessary to inform you in case GRO-A does show any symptoms while in your care.
