You were kind enough to co-operate in the Hepatitis Study by making available Kryobulin for the routine treatment of this boy. Unfortunately, over the past few weeks we have had several severe reactions to this product and Nicholas, who has not had an anaphylactic type reaction for three years, was affected.

Because of the seriousness of one of the episodes I do not think it advisable to give this product to those boys who reacted to it. I am gradually transferring boys on to Hemofil and wonder whether it would be possible for Nicholas to receive this instead of Kryobulin. Failing that, perhaps he could be restricted to Cryoprecipitate.
