As you know this boy is on the hepatitis study and I have just received the results of his L.F.T's of 30th March which are as follows:-

Bilirubin 42 Alk.Phos. 195 SGOT 349 Ttl.Protein 73 Albumin 43

He would appear to be developing hepatitis which is probably associated with an infusion of factor VIII concentrate (Hemofil B) on 15th February 1976. His HBsAb and HBsAg were negative on the 1st March so it is possible that his developing hepatitis may be of the B or non-B type. Please could you let me know if he becomes ill and should you see him I would appreciate further blood samples. If he requires admission I would be pleased to come to Horsham and see him.
