GRO-A was put on alternate day 20% raise for targeting into the right elbow on 18.5.83. Because of a breakthrough bleed on 23.5.83 his prophylaxis was increased to alternate day 30% raise. This will continue until the end of term.

He attends physiotherapy regularly for exercises to his right knee and right elbow which took a long time to regain its full range of movement.

AIDS RELATED INVESTIGATIONS:

Clinically he exhibits none of the stigmata of AIDS. Examination of his superficial lymph nodes on 11.3.83 revealed palpable left cervical, left axillary and bilateral inguinal lymph nodes.

For your information we have undertaken the enclosed AIDS related tests. We have repeated these tests and will let you have the results when they are available.
