AIDS RELATED INVESTIGATIONS:

Clinically he exhibits none of the stigmata of AIDS. Examination of his superficial lymph nodes on 28.2.83 revealed palpable bilateral shotty inguinal lymph nodes. There was no change when re-examined on 9.6.83 apart from a palpable tiny left cervical lymph node.

For your information we have undertaken the enclosed ATDS related tests. We are repeating these before the end of term and will let you have a copy of the results when they are available.
