I have not seen any of those boys for sometime now and providing you think they have grown to be sensible and responsible individuals, I see no reason why they should not go ahead to administer treatment themselves.

On looking through our records I see that none of the boys has Hepatitis B antibody and that they have all been treated mainly with N.H.S. factor VIII although GRO-A has had the occasional dose of Armour. I think if possible they should receive treatment with the N.H.S. material.
