He was tested for Anti HTLV 3 for the first time on 23.1.84 and was found to be positive..

Leigh has been on alternate day prophylaxis during the Christmas holiday. Since stopping prophylaxis on 23.1.85 he has had three bleeds into his right ankle.

He has shown a dramatic improvement in his attitude towards physiotherapy. He has attended all sessions and worked well. He has regained his right elbow's range of movement (now 80 - 140°, was 15 - 132 in November 84).

Leigh will be leaving the sixth form college on Friday the 29th of March 1985, a week later than Jason, for the two weeks Easter holiday.
