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This patient with haemophilia A who gives his own treatment was reviewed recently in the clinic and he was given the result of his anti-HTLV3 antibody test which was positive; this means that he is probably carrying the AIDS virus and has perhaps only a 1 or 2% chance of contracting the disease himself.

I hope shortly to arrange a meeting between the general practitioners who, like yourself, have a HTLV3 antibody positive patients and the members of the department who treat haemophilia, in the fairly near future.
