

BLOOD PRODUCTS - WORKING GROUP/LIKELY TRENDS IN DEMAND

Following the meeting of 20 October which you and Dr Bevan attended, copies of the note have already been circulated but I enclose one for convenience, it has been decided to set up a small working group with the following terms of reference.

"To consider the likely trends in the demand for blood products over the next five to ten years, taking into account the practicabilities of supply".
