PTH(HCV) : FUTURE LITIGATIONS

I do believe it is important that consideration is given to the formulation of an agreed statement of the UK BTS <u>professional</u> position with regard to HCV donation testing.

It seems to me that the key elements which need to be addressed, in the context of a defence position in subsequent litigations, are as follows:

- 1. Why didn't UK BTS introduce surrogate (ALT/Anti-HBc) testing?
- 2. Why was anti-HCV testing delayed until 1st September 1991?

Perhaps we might wish to give this a run round at the next ACTTD meeting. On the other hand, you may feel this would be the most appropriate forum.
