In my capacity as Consultant Haematologist to the Regional Blood Transfusion Service I have been asked to reply to a letter that you sent to the North West Regional Health Authority on January 17th 1985.

It is true that Haemophilia A patients in this Region will only receive Heat-Treated Factor VIII concentrates from this time onwards.

In replying to your second question, you can be sure that the Heat-Treated Factor VIII that you will be issued with for your home treatment will be free of the risk of conveying the HTLV3 (AIDS associated) virus.
