He attended us for the first time on 25 November 1997 and we found an indeterminate Hepatitis C result (details enclosed). I wonder if your laboratory could check his previous results and perhaps retest the archive? He may have had an old infection which is now cleared, but he may well have been infective in 1995/6 and in that case he might need to be entered in the HCV Look Back. Mr GRO-A had extensive transfusions in July 1991 and this could have been the source of his Hepatitis C.
