I reviewed this gentleman in the clinic today. He feels fine and does not have any major complaints. We are still no further as far as acquiring Sofosbuvir for treatment of hepatitis C for him. He had recently requested review of his medical notes and found that from medical notes in Stepping Hill, a do not resuscitate order was put in place in 2010. He is very concerned that this may still hold true and wanted measures to be put in place, so that a new instruction about resuscitation is in place. This gentleman is otherwise well and although has moderately advanced liver disease, he would be a suitable candidate for liver transplantation, should his liver failure get worse. Therefore, in the event of cardio-respiratory arrest, he should be resuscitated; that is his and his family's wish and he wants this instruction not to be reversed until it has been discussed with him or with his family.

I have checked Mr Burney's bloods today and we will see him again in three months time.
