I received the liver biopsy in good condition. The result is $35 \mu g$ iron per mg protein. Our normal range is up to 6 with a median value of 1 (Gastroenterology 79, 877-883, 1980).

It was necessary to homogenize the liver biopsy along with the liquid in the container. I think it is preferable to send the biopsy without liquid but frozen using the smallest possible tube. This avoids any problems of contamination from the solution.

I have assumed that this patient does not have infective hepatitis and is not positive for HTLV3. Would you please make sure that this is the case in future?
