DIAGNOSIS: Chronic hepatitis C (HCV RNA 3.4×10^6 gen eq/ml)
Normal transaminases
No biopsy
Transplant nephrectomy
Dialysis thrice weekly
Right atrial thrombus and on warfarin

I reviewed this lady in clinic recently.

From a liver point of view, things remain completely stable with no evidence of any active hepatitis from her blood picture. She continues with dialysis three times a week and I don't think there is any need for us to have any more input in her care other than just to keep an eye on things. There is certainly no indication for treatment at present. We shall see her again in twelve months but would be delighted to see her before then if necessary.
