William Murphy has now made a complete recovery from his vagotomy and pyloroplasty for a bleeding duodenal ulcer. He has no further bleeding episodes and I expect him to do very well. Unfortunately he developed an acute attack of non-A, non-B hepatitis and again he is making a satisfactory recovery. His liver function tests are not yet normal and I think it would be advisable to follow these every month or so until they are back to normal again. I have told him that he does not have to attend my clinic again in the future and he will be returning to your care. Please let me know if you require any further information.
