WILLIAM MURPHY

I reviewed this man in Haemophilia Clinic today. I note he was seen in the Dental Hospital just over a week ago where they could not readily explain the bleeding from his tongue. This does now appear to be settling however, having had just one episode of bleeding over the last fortnight; lasting for one minute only and settling spontaneously. He is still taking his Tranexamic acid and mouth washes. His new complaint today was that of increasing discomfort at the site of his recurrent hernia. This was originally repaired 2 1/2 - 3 years ago. Over the last six months this has gradually returned and despite the use of a truss he is getting increasing discomfort if he is up and about for more than a hour or two. On examination he has a left inguinal hernia which can be fully reduced. I think he would probably benefit from surgical review, and we will write to his original surgeon in the near future. We shall see him again as previously arranged.
