Thank you for your letter concerning this man. He has an easily reducible hernia due to a recurrence at the internal ring. There is little risk of strangulation. However, the present truss does not control the hernia adequately.

I am most reluctant in view of his attendant conditions to advise operation. He himself, agrees with this view and we both would prefer to try another form of truss. I am arranging for this to be done and we will see how he gets on.
