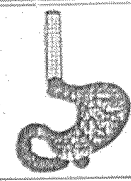

INDICATION: Varices assessment / injection

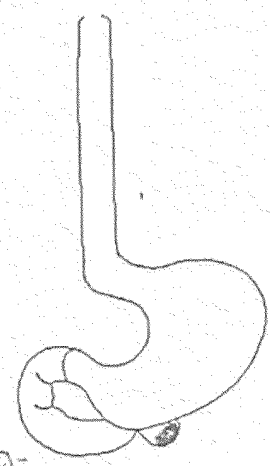

FINDINGS:

OESOPHAGUS: 2 cords of varices (grade II)
Injected 3ml ethanolamine x1
2 1/2 ml " " x1

STOMACH: Normal

DUODENUM: Normal



THERAPEUTIC PROCEDURES: Injection sclerotherapy.

No significant post-injection bleeding

Suggested treatment: *One capsule 20mg po daily (as per chart)

Follow-up: Repeat 4 weeks (will need to see if varices need to be injected).
