You may recall that a few months ago you wrote to me about the above-named patient of yours with hepatocellular carcinoma. I am now trying to pull together as much information as possible about this particular problem and I would be grateful, therefore, if you could find time to let me have some further details of your patient. These are:

- 1. Type of bleeding disorder and severity
- 2. Method of HCC diagnosis and age at diagnosis
- 3. Year of HCC diagnosis
- 4. Date (if known) of first exposure to clotting factor concentrate
- 5. HCV antibody status
- 6. Hepatitis B status
- 7. HIV status
- 8. Alcohol intake (if known)
- 9. Presence or absence (if known) of cirrhosis

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- 10. Alphafetoprotein levels
- 11. It would also be useful to know whether the patient is still alive or whether he has died.
