This man is infected with Hepatitis C and has been under the care of Professor Dusheiko for this. The history was that he obtained this following treatment for haemophilia. He was temporarily registered on the register at Oxford as having a factor VIII of 28 u/dl which subsequently normalised. We performed a full bleeding state workup on the 18th of February, the results of which are enclosed. These are entirely normal, so whatever the nature of his condition was previously he is now normal with respect to the investigations we have performed. I will let him know the results of these.

We now have the results of the bleeding state workup that we performed on the 18th of February and I am pleased to report that everything that we tested for was normal, in particular the factor VIII which was 100 u/dl (normal 50-150).

Thus, whatever the nature of your bleeding disorder was it does seem to have resolved now and we can be reassured about that. I have sent these results to your GP.
