This 13 year old schoolboy with moderately severe von Willebrand's disease attended for 6 monthly review. His main bleeding has consisted of episodes of epistaxis which have responded to infusions of cryoprecipitate.

His general health has been good and he has no joint problems. On examination, I could find no abnormality of his cardiovascular system and abdominal examination was also normal.

His aspartate transaminase is once again elevated at 156 although an alkaline phosphatase of 376 may be normal for a growing child. His AST was also elevated in August 1982, 6 weeks after receiving intermediate factor VIII concentrate and he may have a persistent non-A non-B hepatitis. We will repeat his Liver Function tests at his next visit.
