10.00am fell onto flexed (R) hand 01.00 am this morning - immediate pain & swelling.

Sp. tender over base mid - 1st metacarpal. Severe. Disturbed movements all digits. No ↑ tenderness over 'snuff' box.

Jug = # base 3rd metacarpal - 199
