Dear Doctor

The parents of the above child have requested a referral to yourselves to try to sort out GRO-B emotional problems. This wee boy had a bad start in life suffering from Von Willenbrand's disease and for several years required repeated injections which have thankfully decreased over the years. Unfortunately this has left him with rather a permanent scar in that he is an extremely sensitive and nervous wee boy who is frightened of any physical trauma and especially nervous of Doctors. He has difficulties at school and for the last 3 years has been attending GRO-B. The teachers at school and the parents have noticed over the last year or so a slowly building up problem in that he becomes very upset on minimal stimuli and expresses repeated fears of persecution although there is no good evidence of any bullying. He is a rather lonely and doesn't have many friends as all his near neighbours play football and GRO-B does not like sports of any sorts although he does go horse riding at weekends.

The school unit wished to be involved in his treatment from yourselves and I would be grateful if you could liaise with them. Hopefully efforts can be made to try and nip any further problems in the bud before a much bigger problem arises. Many thanks for your help.
