I would be grateful for your opinion and advice on the above named patient. A brief outline of history, symptoms and signs is given below:

Thank you for seeing this unfortunate young man who has a diagnosis of von Williebrand's disease which is a bleeding disorder. Unfortunately at the age of two he suffered an intracranial subarachnoid haemorrhage following a fall and this has resulted in his need for special education as a young child because of mild mental handicap resulting from his cerebral damage at the time of the haemorrhage. Unfortunately he also has hepatitis C which most likely transmitted through the blood products required for treatment of his bleeding disorder. He is well known to the Haemophilia Centre in The Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh where he attends on a regular basis. He now has left School and is attending GRO-B. Unfortunately he appears to be quite socially isolated with poor interpersonal skills finding it difficult to interact in certain situations. This is perhaps exasperated by his learning difficulties and I would appreciate if you feel you could help develop his assertive skills with a view to improving his self confidence. He feels he would benefit from talking to such a specialist as yourself.
