I would be grateful if you or Alan Harper could see this young man who I have had a brief discussion with Alan about, and mentioned to you recently at the Department Meeting.

As you will see from the GP's referral letter, GRO-B was initially referred to the Adult Department at GRO-B but without any consultation from them, the referral was sent down to GRO-B.

When I met initially with GRO-B and his parents, I wondered if he actually had a learning disability, and indeed subsequent IQ testing indicates that he is in the borderline to low average range of general intellectual functioning. Given that GRO-B has a history of brain injury, does not have a learning disability, and may need prolonged input, I feel he would be more appropriately seen within your service. I have discussed this with GRO-B and his parents and they appear to be quite happy that I should transfer him across to you.

The reason for the referral is clearly outlined in Dr. GRO-B letter, and was confirmed on my initial visit with GRO-B and his parents on 18th February. GRO-B apparently has no friends, and has great difficulty fitting into social groups. He is currently at GRO-B where he is doing a course with people who have 'disabilities'. He seems to have particular problems with ex students of special schools. GRO-B appears to be very stigmatised by disability. GRO-B

In the home context, I did not get the feeling that GRO-B has any particular hobbies or interests, and it may be that Social Work input would be helpful at some stage in the future. I also had a brief chat with GRO-B, Careers Officer, regarding GRO-B. GRO-B says that GRO-B has been doing well at college but in recent months there has been a fall off on his concentration and confidence. She notes that he can get very upset by the conduct of other students and tries to interfere in terms of keeping order in the group.

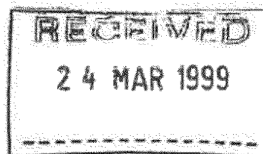
