I saw Mark Stewart today the 12th of November to discuss issues regarding vCJD. He has received clotting factor concentrate of British donor origin between the years 1980 and 2001 and therefore is at risk of vCJD for public health purposes. I have discussed the issues that were detailed in the patient information sheet. His question was of who to blame and he was also concerned about hepatitis C. He was PCR negative for hepatitis on the 25th of November '02 and has normal enzymes and therefore falls into the category of natural clearer. I have explained that 10-15% of patients who were infected with hepatitis C cleared naturally.
