I saw Tiffany Stewart together with her parents today the 12th of November to discuss the issues around vCJD. She has received blood product of British donor plasma origin between 1980 and 2001 and therefore is considered at risk of vCJD for public health purposes. I have discussed with her parents together with Tiffany the issues that were documented in the patient information sheet and answered their questions.

We also discussed the problem of Tiffany's menorrhagia. She is having benefit from injections of von Willebrand factor containing concentrate each month and she comes to the Centre to have that given. I have suggested we review her at our Women's clinic that is held jointly with Miss Rezan Kadir, the Obstetrician and Gynaecologist, in the near future. It may be that if we try and give the treatment immediately before the onset of menstruation it may have even better effect.
