The Combined Liver/Haemophilia Clinic - 2nd June 1997

Patient: Angus Horatio STEWART (Mr) RFH 217032 - DOB: GRO-C/65
GRO-C London GRO-C

Diagnosis: 1. Von Willebrand's Disease
2. Chronic Hepatitis C

We reviewed Mr Stewart in the Liver/Haemophilia Clinic on 2nd June 1997. He has significant level of hepatitis C viraemia at 3.1×10^7 Eq/ml and the predominant genotype is type-3. He was probably infected in 1980 but remarkably he has little in the way of hepatobiliary symptoms. His liver enzymes are moderately deranged with AST 120 u/l, ALT 135 u/l, and GGT 110 u/l. He has stopped consuming alcohol and now is a good timing to start him on alpha-interferon therapy. A number of baseline investigations have been requested. Thereafter he will be reviewed in the Haemophilia Centre and be given instructions on how to administer the subcutaneous injection.
