Dear Dr. GRO-B

I saw this patient, who suffers from moderately severe Haemophilia A at the Haemophilia Clinic on the above date. As you will be aware, he is HIV negative, but Hepatitis C virus positive. He has been vaccinated against Hepatitis B.

He has been well since his last visit to the clinic and has not required treatment of factor since February 1992. He is bothered by mild arthritis in his right ankle, but this is well controlled with using more supportive shoes and boots.

At present, he is taking TETRACYCLINE for acne.

I note he now has a job with

He told us

he would get in touch with us when he knows where he will be living in London so we can arrange follow-up with a nearby Haemophilia Centre.

GRO-B has been informed today that he is Hepatitis C positive and told him to avoid alcohol in large amounts. His most recent transaminases of last October showed an AST of 58 and ALT 135 which is higher than normal and reflects his underlying Hepatitis. His full blood count, Factor VIII level, inhibitors and liver function tests are being repeated today.

I have arranged a follow up appointment for six month's time for GRO-B to come back to see us, if he is in Scotland at that time. I do not foresee seeing him again in the near future unless he requires to when up in Scotland.
