 - 3 Right coronary artery occlusion
 - 4 Infero-posterior MI 2003
 - 5 Hypercholesterolaemia
 - 6 Previous alcohol excess

I reviewed this patient at Dr Mills' Liver Clinic today. I am pleased to say that this gentleman is keeping very well and is quite keen to be considered for treatment for his hepatitis C. He thinks that he may have contracted the virus through a blood transfusion in 1975. His genotype is 1a and he would require one year's worth of treatment. I explained this to the gentleman briefly going into what is involved with treatment and potential side-effects. Having spoken to Dr Mills, he is happy for this gentleman to be put forward for hepatitis C treatment and I will ask Sister Spence our liver specialist nurse to put him on the waiting list. He has a review appointment for this clinic in one year's time.
