Comment: Thanks for seeing this non-smoking man with a year of wheezy episodes, shortness of breath at night and several chest infections. He has haemophilia and contracted Hep C which is now cleared. He has had symptomatic benefit from salbutamol and prednisolone during exacerbations but his peak flow readings have not improved with salbutamol. His spirometry in July of this year was normal. I have tried him on a steroid inhaler as a trial but I am grateful for your review.
