Diagnosis:

1. Severe haemophilia
2. HIV - positive
3. Hepatitis C - positive
4. Severe haemophilic arthropathy of the left knee

Thank you for your letter of 25<sup>th</sup> March, enquiring about Michael.

He is doing reasonably well. His main problem is related to the severe haemophilic arthropathy of his left knee. The major problem he had in relation to his HIV infection was severe seborrhoeic dermatitis. His current medication consists of AZT and DDI as well as nebulised Pentamidine. He developed a severe reaction to prophylactic Septrin.

I enclose a print out of his CD4, CD8 and total lymphocyte count. He was started on the AZT/DDI in November last year by our G.U. Physician, who specialises in HIV infection in the area.

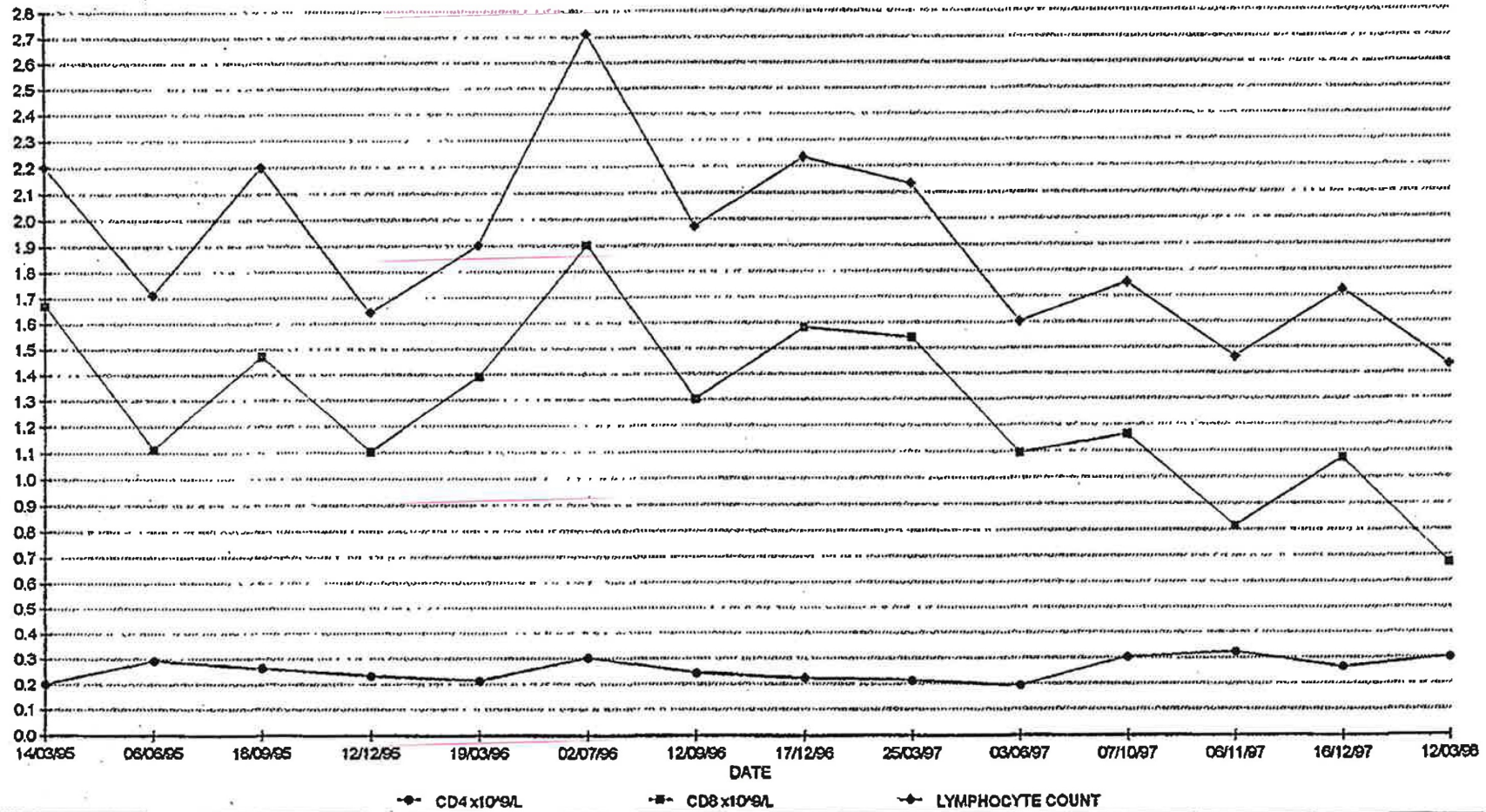
