Re: **GRO-B** - D.O.B. **GRO-B** 1964

To confirm our telephone conversation from earlier today. It was our understanding that Mr [redacted] was due to have a dental extraction today & we therefore arranged for him to be treated this morning before coming down to you.

He was Treated with Factor VIII 2000iu at 0910 this morning and also received a dose of 1 gram of Tranexamic Acid orally. He was issued with a supply of Tranexamic Acid to take home with him as per the treatment plan from Dr Chowdary. I also counselled him that if there were any unexpected bleeding he should return here to the Royal Free for further Factor Replacement.

We discussed on the telephone that you had kindly agreed to slot the procedure in today although it had not been your expectation that this appointment was for the extraction. The half life of Factor VIII is 12 hours and I suggested that it would be fine to proceed as long as the extraction took place before 3pm today.

I informed Dr Pratima Chowdary (haemophilia consultant) of our discussion & she had nothing to add to the agreed plan
