This is to let you know that we have recently found out that your patient should not have been notified in 2004 that they were at risk of vCJD for public health purposes because they had only received blood product made from USA sourced plasma. This error arose because there were two sorts of BPL product in use from 1999 to 2001, batches from UK plasma and batches from US plasma. Your patient only received the US plasma sourced batches and is therefore deemed safe for public health purposes in relation to vCJD.

I would most grateful if you would change your records to take note of their changed status and remove any information sheets, stickers or other flags indicating risk from case records you hold. We have informed the patient directly (copy enclosed)
