DIAGNOSIS

Hepatitis C virus cirrhosis
Von Willebrand's disease
Multifocal hepatocellular carcinoma

This gentleman's scans were reviewed in the Hepatobiliary Multidisciplinary Team meeting today at the Royal Free Hospital.

His largest lesion is 4.2 cm and on the angiogram there are at least 10 arterial enhancing lesions. On the new CT the largest lesion is satisfactorily embolised, although there seems to be an ongoing area of arterial enhancement in the left lobe. Dr Yu feels that this possibly represents a new lesion.

It is therefore clear that this gentleman's burden of tumour is outside conventional transplant criteria and the finding of the new arterialised lesion on this most recent CT points to an adverse biology of disease.

I will communicate these findings to him. It may be that he wishes to seek a second opinion elsewhere. If this is the case I will provide him with copies of his images here at the Royal Free Hospital. In the interim further embolisation maybe appropriate and I will discuss this with him when I see him in the clinic.
