I can confirm that all tests are completely NEGATIVE (both by ourselves and by the Virus Reference Laboratory, Glasgow) thus indicating no evidence of sero-conversion to HIV. In view of the interval between transfusion and this blood sample it can be assumed that sero-conversion is now highly unlikely.
