Mr Spellman remains fairly well. He feels significantly better since he stopped Interferon, with improved energy and has no further complaints with gum bleeding. He still complains of painful feet with neuropathic type pain and lots of sensation.

Blood tests are currently acceptable, haemoglobin is slowly improving, 9.5 with reasonable iron stores. He is on maximum dose EPO and hopefully this will improve now his Interferon has been withdrawn.

Dialysis is uncomplicated. Dry weight 73kg, weight gains 1.5 - 2kg. Pre-dialysis bp 143/57, post 111/59. AV fistula QB 380, AP -100, VP 120, OCM 1.8.

I have made no changes to his medication today. He is due to be reviewed by the hepatologist and the transplant assessment team next month.
