Diagnosis: Severe Haemophilia

High Level High responding Inhibitor

Hepatitis C

I understand that this 30-year-old gentleman has transferred his care to your Centre. I just wanted to outline the problems of his Haemophilia over the past few years. He has been attending the Manchester Centre since 1997. He has severe haemophilia as well as inhibitors (July 2002 human factor VIII inhibitors 10.8 BU, porcine factor VIII inhibitor 3.2 BU's) he is currently treated with FEIBA home treatment for recurrent bleeds which vary in frequency. Usually he has bleeds in his left elbow and to a lesser extent his right knee and both ankles can be affected. He has got slight restriction of movement of his right knee and a limited dorsa flexion of his right and left ankles. His right ankle occasionally locks and there is a palpable click. Both his elbows have got fixed flexion and moderate rejection in pronation and supranation.

He also has got a very poor dental state and requires several dental extractions. Unfortunately he is not very compliant and this might prove difficult to get him to see the dentist at all.

He has got hepatitis C with persistently abnormal LFT's and had a three-month trial of treatment with Interferon monotherapy in Liverpool a few years back. This had to be discontinued as he apparently tolerated it very badly and also there was a big question mark over his compliance. Due to arthritic pain he is currently on Brufen together with Lansoprazole and he has also a known Dihydrocodeine dependency.

His most recent hepatitis C RNA was positive in April this year and his hepatitis B surface antibody was between 100 and 500 lu in January this year. His most recent liver function tests show an ALT of 51, alkaline phosphatase 386 otherwise normal LFT's.
