Clinical History :

Indication: Hepatitis. Pre-treatment assessment.

Findings: There are several calculi present within the gallbladder. The common hepatic duct is normal in calibre. No focal parenchymal abnormality is seen within the liver. The liver echotexture is slightly coarsened but the outline appears relatively smooth. The pancreas is not well seen due to overlying bowel gas. The spleen is not enlarged. The aorta is normal in calibre. Both kidneys are normal in size and echo pattern. No free fluid is seen.

Conclusion: Cholelithiasis. No focal hepatic abnormality.

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
