Dear Professor Lee,

I am writing to you for advice on a rather difficult situation we are experiencing with one of our patients suffering from haemophilia.

The patient is aged 24 and acquired Hep.C through infected treatment approximately 11 years ago. He is currently receiving Factor VIII but has been informed a few years ago that he had received a treatment that was later found to be distilled from donations one of which came from someone who later died from nvCJD.

His mother is requesting that he be given access to Recombinant Factor VIII on a named patient basis. I am aware that this treatment is currently only available automatically to under 16's but the Department of Health are considering extending this to all haemophiliacs regardless of age.
